









Western Harbour Tunnel, Stage 2 is a major transport infrastructure project that will make it easier, faster and safer to travel around Sydney. Design changes introduced by ACCIONA created a construction solution that better balances environmental impacts with construction capabilities.



Sydney Metro West will support a growing city and deliver world-class metro services to more communities. This new underground metro railway will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.



The Adelaide Desalination Plant was constructed to safeguard urban water supplies and ensure that sufficient water is available to meet Adelaide's needs in extremely dry years. The plant was built following the Millennium Drought to provide a source of water which is not dependent on the climate.



The Bunbury Outer Ring Road is a transformational infrastructure project, ranked as the largest regional infrastructure project ever undertaken in WA.



By constructing additional crossings of the Coomera and Nerang rivers, Stage 1 of the Coomera Connector will reduce pressure on the M1 by providing an alternative route for the growing communities and commercial hubs of Helensvale and Coomera.



Rookwood Weir is a landmark project that will provide valuable water which will underpin agricultural, industrial and urban growth in Central Queensland. The project is a leader in its commitment to deliver sustainable infrastructure solutions.



Southern Program Alliance (SPA) is one of the four ongoing program Alliances established to deliver the Level Crossing Removal Program. ACCIONA, along with its Alliance partners, are bringing design and construction excellence to infrastructure along Melbourne's Frankston and Hurstbridge lines.



Opened in June 2023, this 18.5km four-lane motorway will contribute to the economic growth of the Northland region and provides a more reliable and secure transportation link between Auckland, Waikato and Tauranga.
