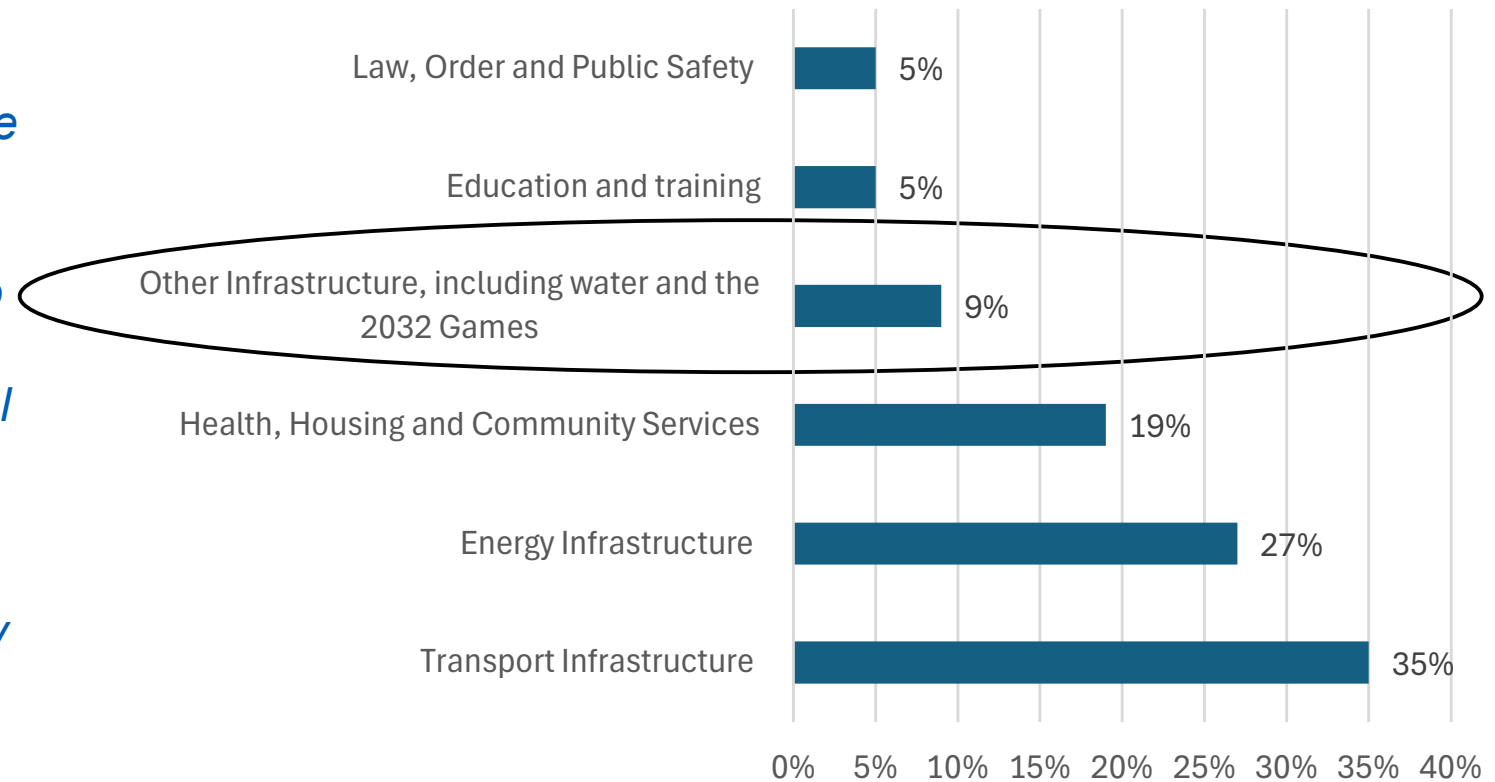

Capital Purchases by purpose 2025-26

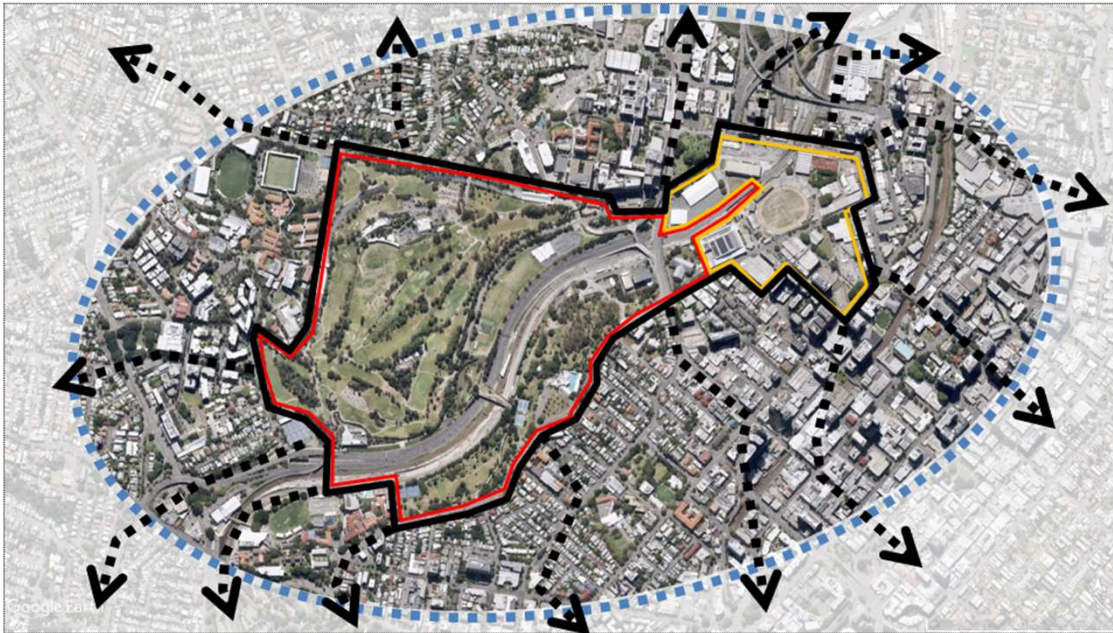

- ✓ Principal Contractor for Phase 1 awarded to ARUP on 17 September

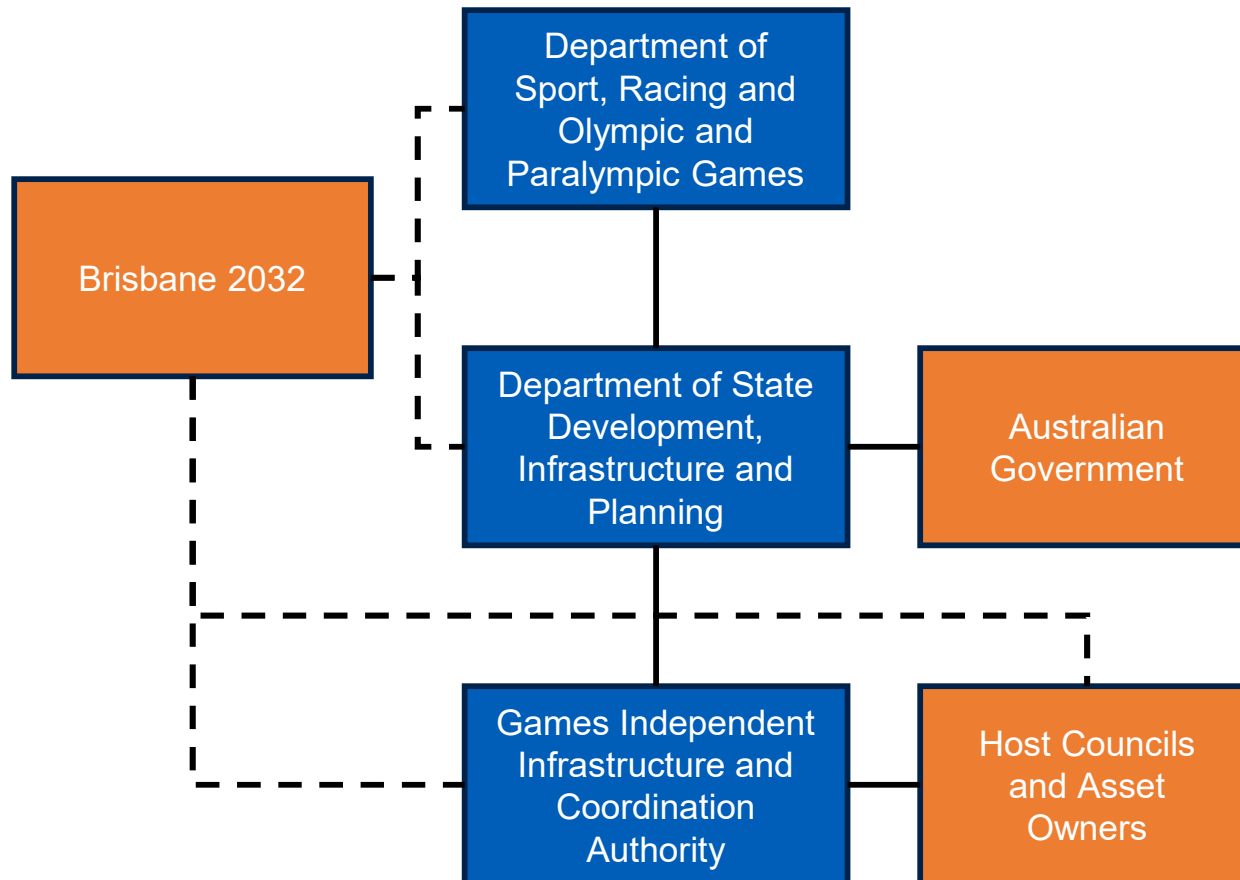
Phase 2 – Integrated Master Plan

- » Detailed master plan – focus on user experience, public and green spaces and integrated design outcomes



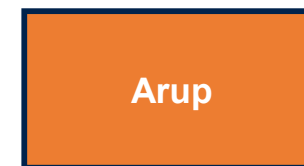

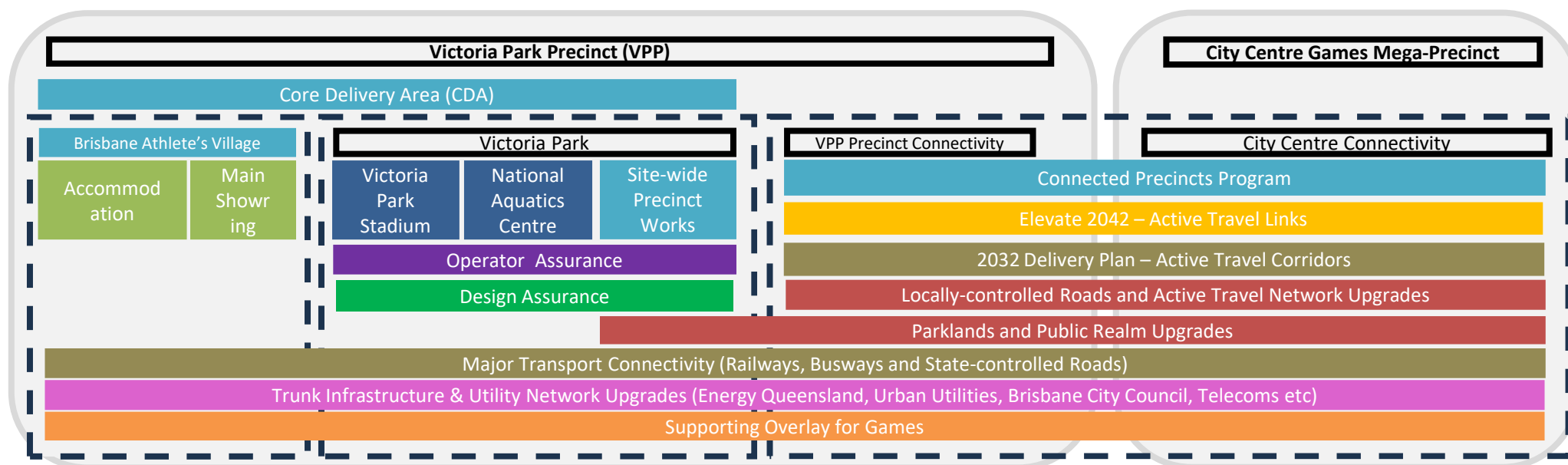
