



Key Drivers of Construction Activity, QLD




QLD Government Capital Purchases 2025/26






QLD Construction Pipeline




Pipeline as of June 2025: \$57.6b

QLD Engineering Pipeline (work yet to be done) As of June 2025: \$23.0b





Value of Non-residential Activity
















Average Labour Requirement - QMPP

Average labour requirement, by funding status












Key Occupations - QMPP


Key construction occupations in demand, average (2025/26 to 2029/30)





Regional Labour Requirement - QMPP


Labour requirement by region and funding status, average (2025/26 to 2029/30)

Labour requirement by region and sector, average (2025/26 to 2029/30)









The 2032 Games Venues & Villages Pipeline

Average labour demand for the 2032 games, by financial year



Average labour demand for the 2032 Games, by region and financial year








The 2032 Games – Key Occupations
